Report Summary

Based on the report sent out by the PreCog Department, we have been able to track down a few similar events in history and potentially methods to counteract some of the effects of the possible symptoms.

Based on the information regarding the English settlement, we have a 96% positive match for information regarding the Roanoke Colony from 1587 ad, where 117 settlers disappeared without any indication as to what happened to them. Reports from the time showed that a majority of people questioned about people that had gone to the colony had no idea who those people were and had claimed they had never met people by those names. This included immediate family members and spouses.

The colony leader (John White) had returned to England before the disappearance had occurred, to gather supplies for the colony, but upon his return, all people in the colony had disappeared.

White and his crew on the ship were some of the only people who actively remembered all the people who were in the colony. White later spent the rest of his life investigating what had happened to the people of Roanoke, and kept journals on the information he had found. TIA has requested the journals from WH13 for review, along with any other relevant items to assist with the investigation.

Another relatively high match (86%) is a part of the Mayan Empire. While not entirely forgotten or missing, there have been parts of the empire that have recently been found in wildly overgrown parts of the jungles that have very similar elements to both the PreCog's reports and our understanding of the Roanoke Colony.

Most Mayan Ruins have remains of inhabitants, the areas in question show no signs of human remains, while they do show signs that people did live at these locations.

There is also a rub done by an archaeologist from 1984 (Dr. Shannon Laurie) at one of the abandoned ruin sites that could be translated to potentially translated to “Croatoan”, which was a word etched into a wooden post found at the abandoned Roanoke Colony.

TIA History Department has requested any artifacts for WH13 that may be relevant to the investigation.
