Report Summary

During normal observations of our precog's while they slept, monitoring agents observed an increased activity in the temporal lobe of all the sleeping precog agents starting at 0100. Shortly after, there were violent spikes in the hippocampus, as well as screaming coming from the precogs.

Based on the recordings, some precogs woke up from the pain, while others remained asleep, screaming and writhing from the pain. Unfortunately, we lost a precog agent during the incident, which will be filled in a separate 'loss of life' report.

Monitoring team and TIA Medical attempted to work to reduce the pain and locate the cause, but were unable to provide any real assistance at the time.

At approximately 0210, the precog agent's brain scans returned to normal. When asked about the incident afterward, all the precogs remembered the pain, but they did not remember the cause or the images they saw. Many described the pain as though someone was ripping things forcibly out of their minds.

With the permission of the precog team, reviews of the dream scans were performed. While normal scans often have visions of many different things, both unrelated personal elements, along with potential clues, the scans from the precogs during this time window resembled something closer to watching scrambled channels on TV.

Information that we were able to gather is listed below. This report will be shared with all department leads to see if more information can be gathered.

- The pending threat involves a large populated area, most likely Chicago and/or surrounding communities.

- There will be a period of increased violence in areas where people gather
- Images from a English settlement both populated and empty
- Images of people walking in Chicago, phasing to images of extreme violence, then finally no evidence of people.
- While observing the scan, it appears that people were being actively removed from the scan at the time of the scan being taken.
- Running tests on the scans showed degradation significantly higher than normal scans.
